

Checkoff List for Wednesday Story Deadline

Story Requirements

- ✓ Typed in Times New Roman, 12 pt., 1-inch margins on all sides; MLA heading
- ✓ Your headline should be centered and written in headline style with a subject and verb, such as “Soldiers hold their fire on Christmas Day”
- ✓ Single space the writing.
- ✓ No indents for paragraphs; just skip a line between paragraphs.
- ✓ Highlight or underline sections of your story where there is specific history research; in the margins indicate where that info comes from (book title and page, website name, etc.). *However you do this markup, make it easy for your teachers to trace where that info comes from.*

Annotated Works Cited

- ✓ Follow directions and sample style as shown in class and on website. This should be stapled behind your story.

Notes / Peer Editing Paper and First Draft

- ✓ Staple the yellow peer editing paper on top, then your first draft that you brought to class on that day, and then your original three or more sources of notes at the end.

Remember: Turnitin.com deadline is 11:59 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 15. If you fail to submit to Turnitin.com, your writing will be lowered by *at least* two letter grades.

Procrastinator’s Pass: Because turning in the actual writing one day late (with a Procrastinator Pass) will not impact the group’s work, you **may** use a Procrastinator Pass for this writing portion of the assignment only; your work will be turned in by Thursday, Feb. 14, with a Turnitin.com deadline of 11:59 p.m. on Friday, Feb. 15.
